



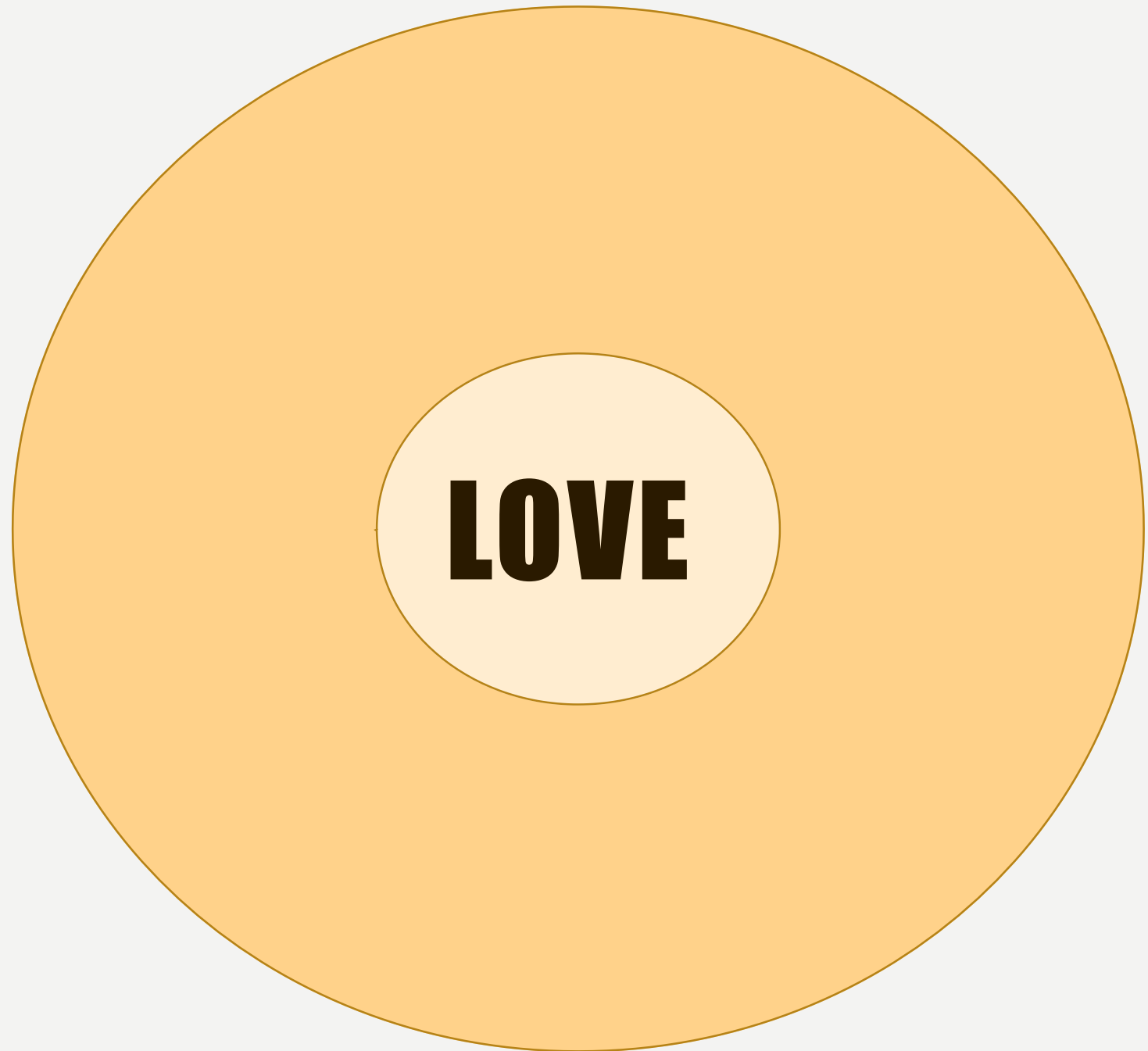

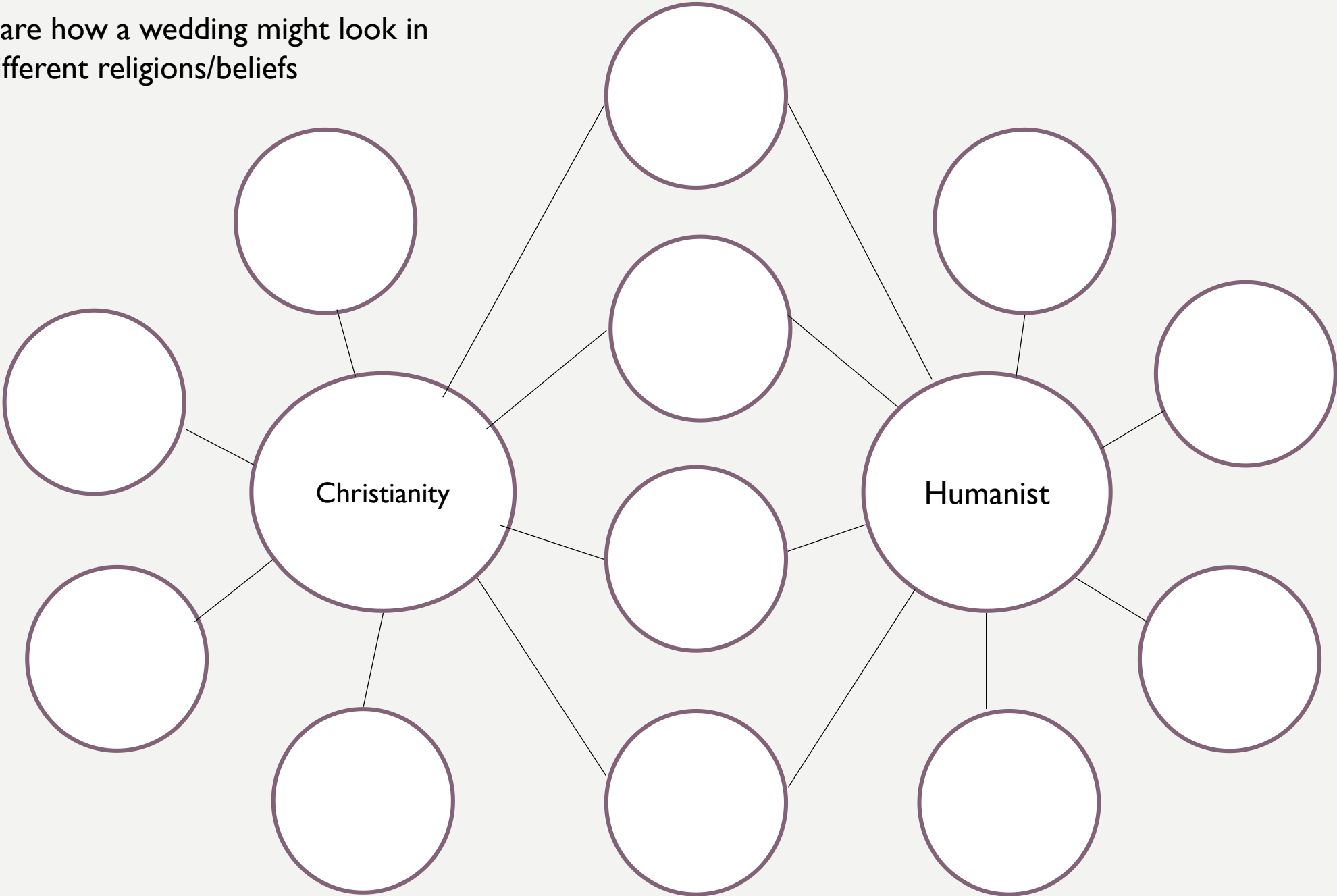


Marriage legally unites a couple in the eyes of the law which gives them certain privileges and protection.

## Marriage:

- Acquire parental responsibilities of children.
- Next of kin rights (they will inherit your property when you pass away for example, unless their will states otherwise).
- They would inherit life insurance money.
- United in the eyes of the law.
- Your partner has the right to live with you.
- Marriage is intended to be a life-long partnership.
- Marriage only became legal for same sex couples in 2013.
- Marriage is often linked to religion
