What have we been up to this term?

Year 2

Year 2 have been learning to greet and hold a simple and short conversation in Spanish. Some vocabulary they have used:

¡Hola! - Hello! ¡Adiós! – Goodbye! ¿Cómo estás? – how are you?

Year 4

In Year 4 we have practised how to say our name, age and where we live, also learning numbers up to 20. Some vocabulary they have used:

¿Cuántos años tienes? – How old are you?

Dónde vives? – Where do you live? Vivo en Ilford – I live in Ilford

Year 6 have discussed what subjects they like and do not like at school and what day and time they study each one. Some vocabulary:
