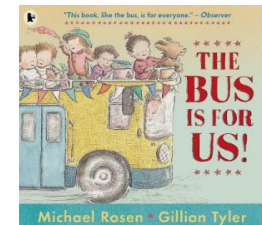
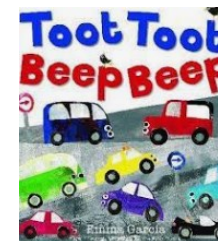
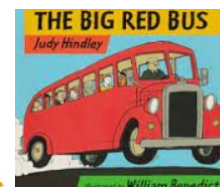

## Nursery learning

We are excited to welcome the children back to Nursery for the spring term! They will continue to develop their communication, social and academic skills through a play based curriculum.

This term we are learning about transport and will be sharing stories to find out more. The children will have the opportunity to engage with lots of related creative activities such as building junk model vehicles and making traffic lights. We will be going for a walk in the local community to do a traffic survey.

The children will also be taking part in some science experiments to find out more about the importance of handwashing.

We will be practising number skills to 5 by doing daily counting, subitising and recognition activities. The children will also be learning how to hear syllables, rhymes and initial sounds in words.
