History


This half-term, children will learn about the successful invasion by Claudius and conquest of Britain by Romans, the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain, British resistance, for example Boudica, and Roman withdrawal from Britain in 410AD.

Reading Mastery

We will read the book 'Charlotte's Web' by E.B.White.

In our Reciprocal Reading sessions, we will be retrieving information and making inferences from the text. Every week, ten new words will be sent home for children to learn, so please question your children for meaning and understanding of those words.



Science

We will identify how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating, recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear, find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it, find patterns between the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it. and recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.
