During the week of SATs children will be expected to come in early as they did for their mocks at 8am for pre-teach sessions in order to prepare them for the relevant tests.



English

We will be reading Holes by Louis Sachar. Children will be taught how to use features to write a narrative and create a persuasive leaflet with powerful persuasive features. They will apply neat and legible cursive handwriting as well as grammar and punctuation taught throughout the year.

Maths

Children will review their understanding of arithmetic and reasoning topics taught over the year. They will hone in their reasoning skills and demonstrate a secure knowledge of maths.






Children will be learning about Islamic civilization- Baghdad C.AD 900. Children will explore the life of Muhammad (pbuh) and his significance in the origins of the early Islamic civilisation. They will explore why the civilization spread so widely. Children will further develop their understanding of the reliability of different historical sources by using a varied range.





Children will be using textiles to make a pencil case. They will design and make products that have a combination of working functions and aesthetic qualities. They will be using stitchwork to combine materials together.



Science



The children will discover the scientific views on how different species have changed over time. They will explore what characteristics offspring can inherit from their parents and make hypotheses based on their learning.





The topic focus for 'Relationship, Health Education (RHE)' sessions is **Health and Prevention and Internet Safety and Harm.** The aim of this topic is to provide information about basic first aid and knowing when to seek support about their physical and mental health.



Please ensure your child attends school on time every day. If s/he has a mild cough/cold or a blocked nose or feels tired, this is not a reason to stay at home.
