Dear Parents / Carers,

Welcome back! We hope that you and your children had a restful break.

The children have settled back into their learning activities and are motivated and actively engaged in their lessons. It is hard to believe that they are now coming to the end of their time in Year 4. You will be pleased to know that the children have made remarkable progress in all areas of learning: curricular, cocurricular and extra-curricular.

This is a very important half-term for the children; they will take the Multiplication Table Check on Monday, 10th June, and we are sure they will do well. Children will also be consolidating and extending the learning covered in Year 4, so that firm foundations are laid, ready for their transition into Year 5.



English

This term, we will continue reading the book, 'The Anglo-Saxon Boy'. We will be exploring the text and opportunities within it for creative writing. This half-term, children will learn how to write a narrative based on the style of the author, Tony Bradman.



Maths

Time, Shapes, Statistics and Position and Direction- Children will learn how to tell the time on both analogue and digital clocks. In Statistics, we will be looking at presenting and interpreting data. Children will learn about shapes.

Geography

Children will learn about Coasts. They will learn about erosion and Deposition and the landforms formed because of erosion and deposition. Children will also learn about types of sea defences and look at how our coasts have changed over time.

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We will continue reading the book 'Anglo Saxon Boys' by Tony Bradman. In our Reciprocal Reading sessions, we will be retrieving information, making inferences from the text, using context clues to infer the meaning of words and making predictions.





States of Matter- Children will consolidate their knowledge about states of matter.

They will observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled, identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle.

Homework

We appreciate your support in your child's homework. We request that you support their wider learning too. Examples of this support could include: asking questions regarding mental maths strategies - money calculations when shopping, weighing ingredients when cooking, time questions using clocks etc.



Please only keep your child at home if s/he is very unwell. If s/he just has a mild cough or a blocked nose your child should attend.

Please remember, every day consists of 8 lessons which your child is missing if they are not in school. They will very quickly fall behind
