English

In English we will be looking at the texts "All are Welcome' and 'Giraffes Can't Dance'. We will be focusing on making predictions, retelling the stories and also writing character descriptions.



Maths

This term we will be focusing on number work, different ways of representing numbers, counting and number bonds to 10. We will be reading and writing these numbers in numerals and words and using them to solve problems involving addition and subtraction.





Geography

In Geography this half- term, children will be exploring our local area by going on a learning walk. They will be discussing how Ilford has changed and also comparing the physical features to the natural features, introducing geographical vocabulary





Children will learn to identify and label the basic parts of the human body including naming and labelling the parts of their face. Also, we will be investigating to find out if height is linked to shoe size.
