Maths

This term, our focus will be on Multiplication & Division and Area.

Furthermore, the focus on Mastery Number will continue.



History



This half-term children will continue to learn about the achievements of Ancient Egyptians and explain how and why the Egyptians mummified people.

Geography

This half-term, children will learn about Stratford before and after regeneration in 2012 (Olympics in London). They will then look at land use in Stratford during their Fieldwork and compare it with the way land is used in their local area.

Reading Mastery



This half-term, children will focus on a non-Fiction text about the Human Body which links with our Science topic this term. This will help them understand the features of a non-fiction text and retrieve facts from non-fiction.

Science



Animals Including Humans- Children will learn about the functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans, different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions, construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.
